MUSICIANS during COVID have had it tough, but Jazz singer Paula Renee is going where no musician has been before – singing underwater.

Paula has teamed up with the Busselton Jetty to create “Jazz Under the Jetty” – a series of events starting Saturday September 18, delivered 8m below the ocean surface.

Busselton Jetty CEO Lisa Shreeve said many industries have had to pivot during COVID including the Arts and Tourism.

“We are lucky in WA we can still go to world class events like this featuring live music, seafood and for this event beautiful Margaret River region Wills Domain wines.”

Paula said she was excited about singing in the Underwater Observatory (UWO) on the ocean floor.

“Jazz music itself can be immersive, but in a magical and unique environment like this I’m sure it’s going to be truly memorable and I can’t wait to see how the marine life will respond.”

The Jazz under the Jetty series will also feature on Saturday October 23, November 13, December 11 and January 15 next year.

Along with Wills Domain red and white wines, the event features Shucked Oysters, Scallops, Prawns, Fish, Crab, Squid and other delectable canapes.
